



Web Development, Defined


Web development is the creation and management of both websites and web-based applications.





The Front-End (The look and feel)

Everything that users visually see in their web browser or application.




The Back-End (How it works)

Everything that communicates between the database and the web browser.




The Front-End: A Closer Look

- Powers the visuals and interactions the user sees.
- The structure and style of the website or application.
- Includes accessibility, performance, cross-browser, and cross-device functionality.



The Front-End: What You See






The Front-End Comprises...






The Back-End: A Closer Look


- What goes on behind the scenes.
- Most of the code that exists today is on the back-end and never seen by users.
- Building the actual logic behind the application and the architecture of the system.















What Is HTML? (Cont.)





HTML: Hypertext Markup Language

- HTML is made up of tags.
- Tags tell the browser how to format content (e.g., will the content be formatted as an image or as a link?)



Anchors






Attributes (Cont.)

Attributes are additional information we add to an element.

- They appear in the opening tag of the element.
- They are made up of two parts: a name and a value, separated by "=".



Attributes (Cont.)

Image elements also require attributes!

- This tells the browser what image should be rendered on the page.
- Alternate tags tell robots what is depicted in the image (you're not the only one reading what's in the browser!).





Web font services — like Google Fonts — allow us to ensure that all users can see the same font.

- Navigate to <u>Google Fonts</u>.
- Search "Raleway" and click the "+" button to select the font.
- Search "Lato" and click the "+" button to select the font.
- Click the tab that pops up at the bottom:



- Click the "Embed" tab and "@import."
- Copy the import code and paste it in your CSS file in CodePen.




